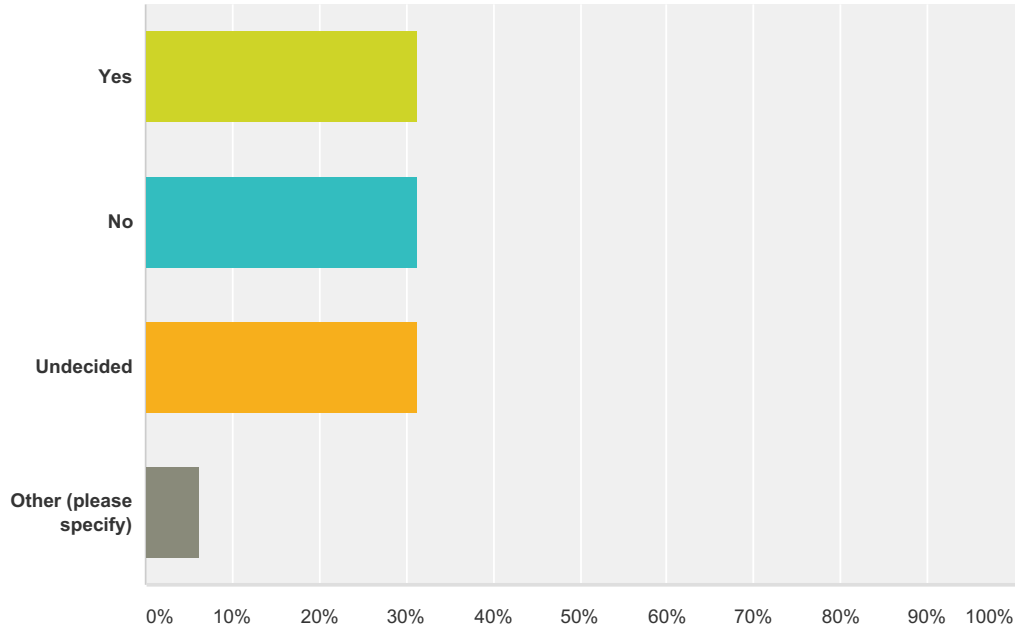

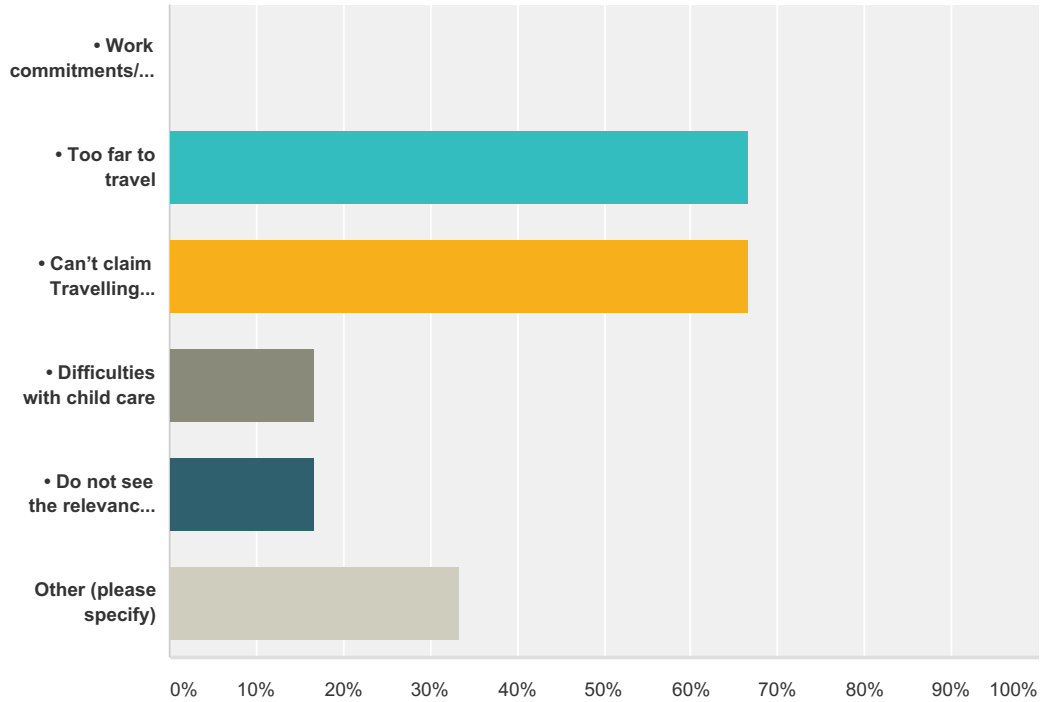

Q2 if you have answered 'no', do you mind telling us your reason for not attending ? (You may select multiple answers)

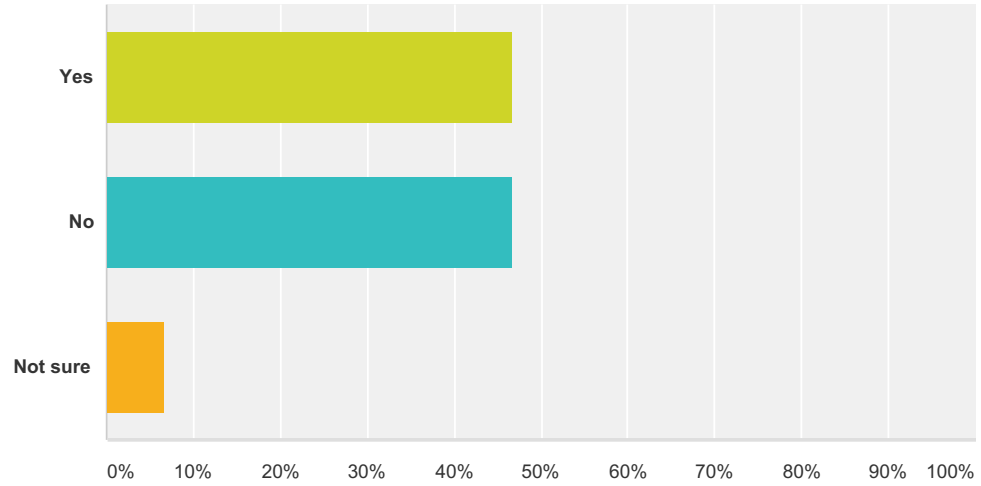

Q3 Would you be more inclined to attend the Awards Ceremony if it was held on a weekend?

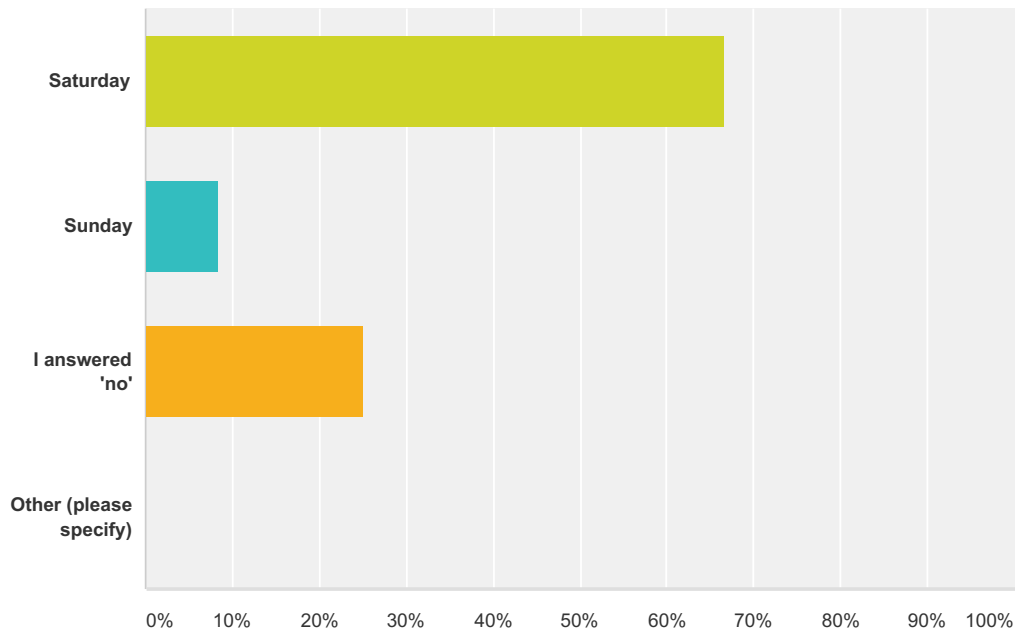

Q4 If you answered YES, then which day would you prefer ?

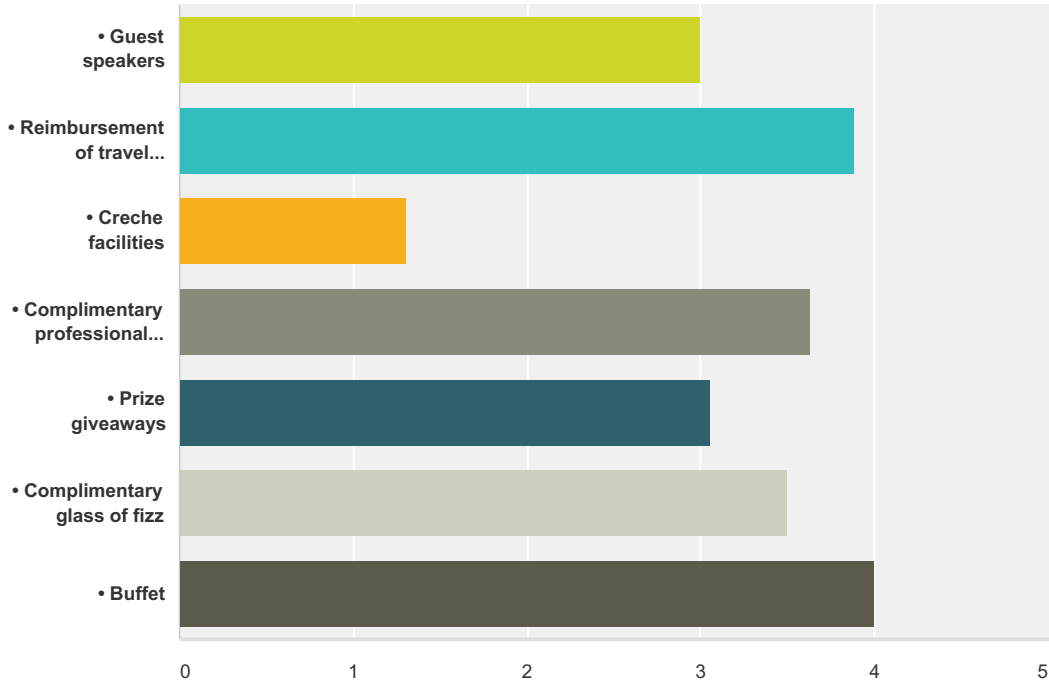

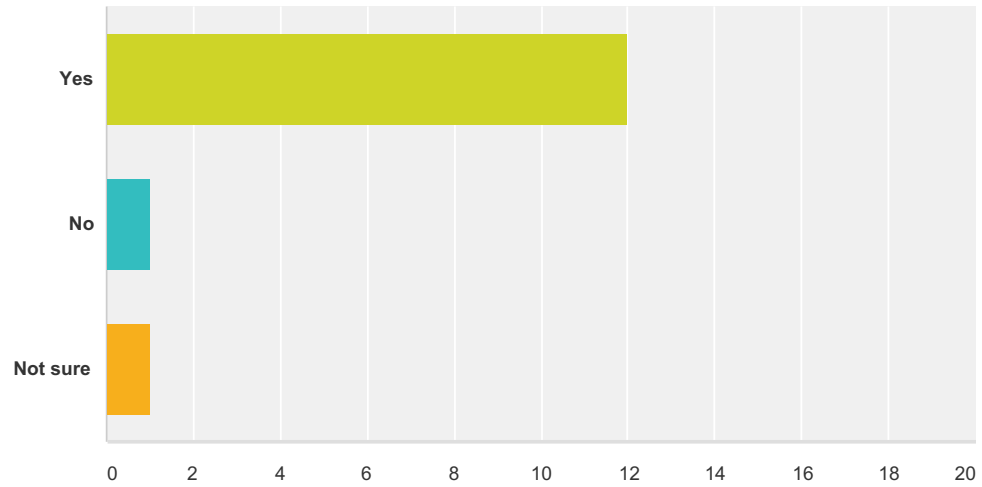

Q1 For some people who didn't attend, it was because they couldn't get time off work. Would you have still come had the Awards event been on a Saturday?

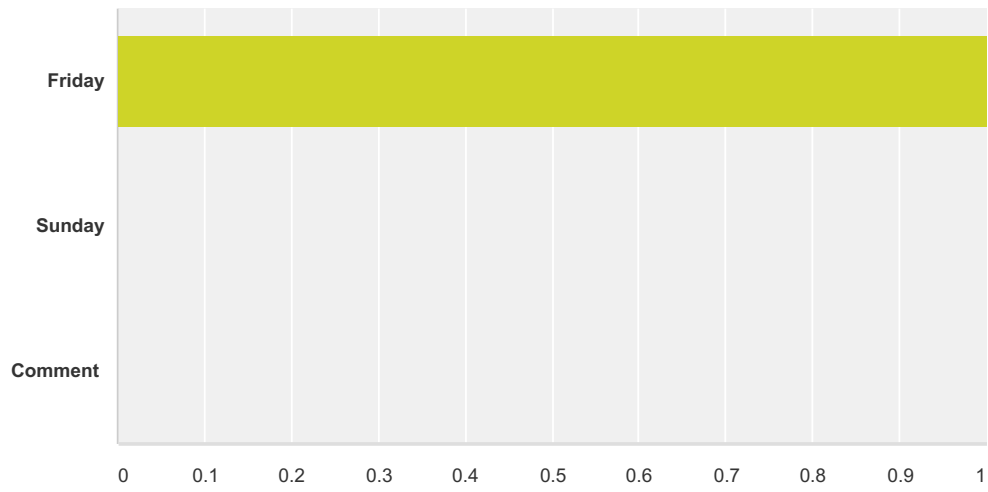

Q2 If you answered NO, then which day would you prefer ?

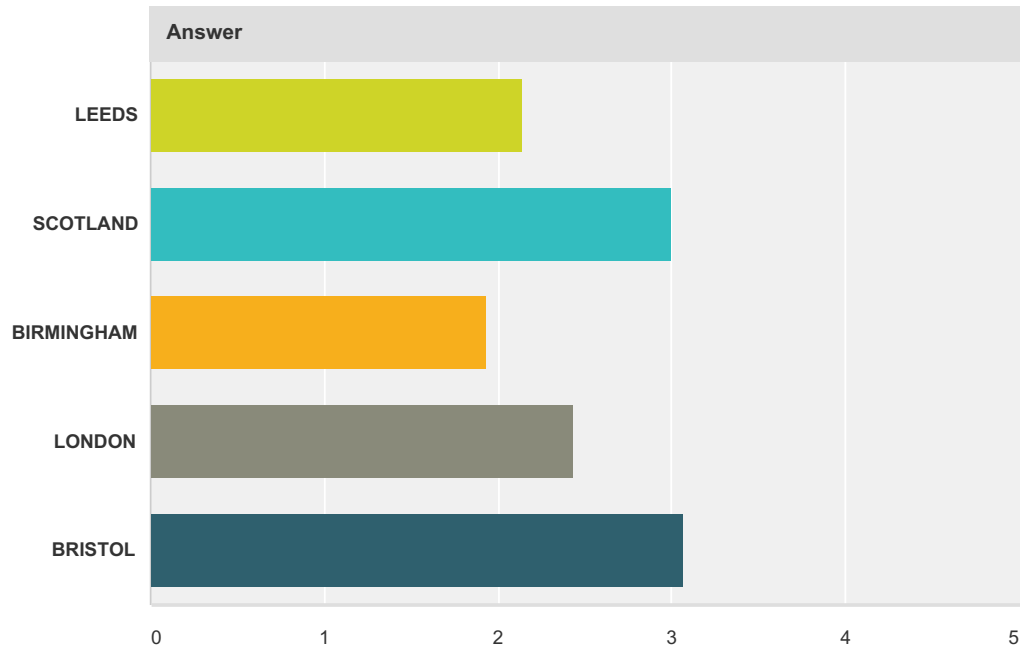

Q3 The selection of location may be key to people's ability to attend, so would you have attended the Awards ceremony this year had it been in:

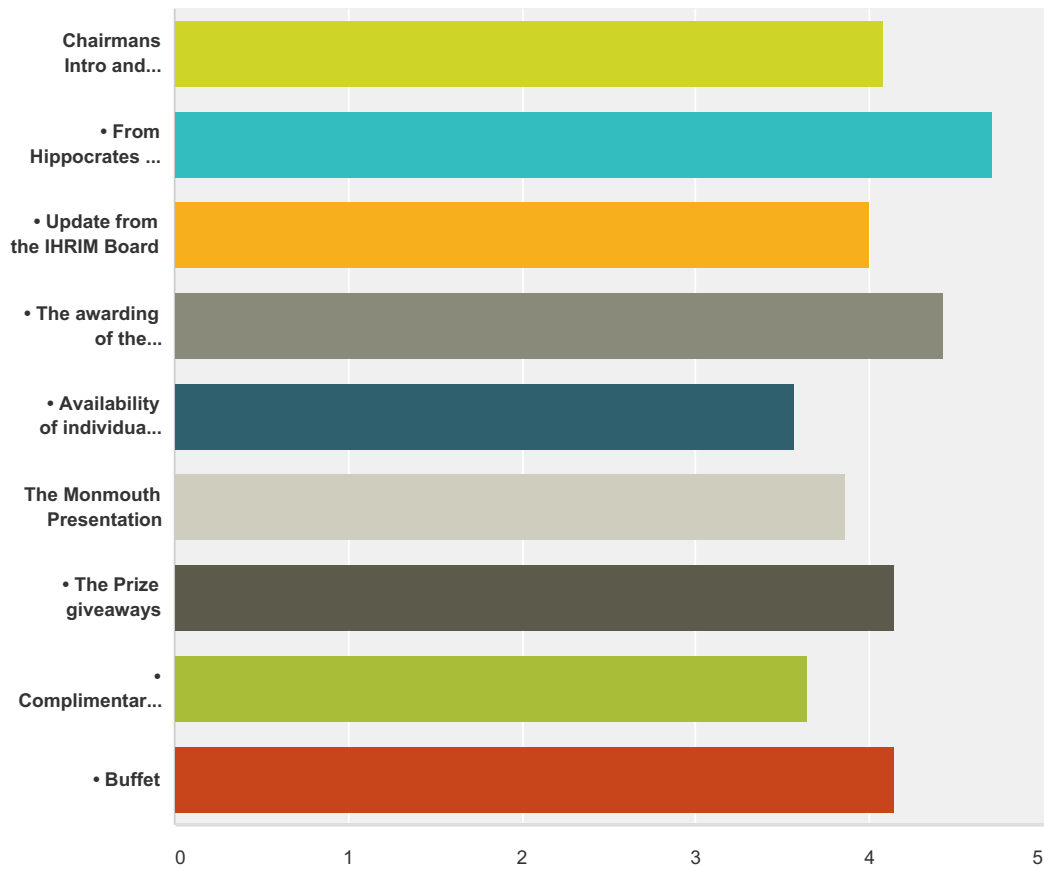

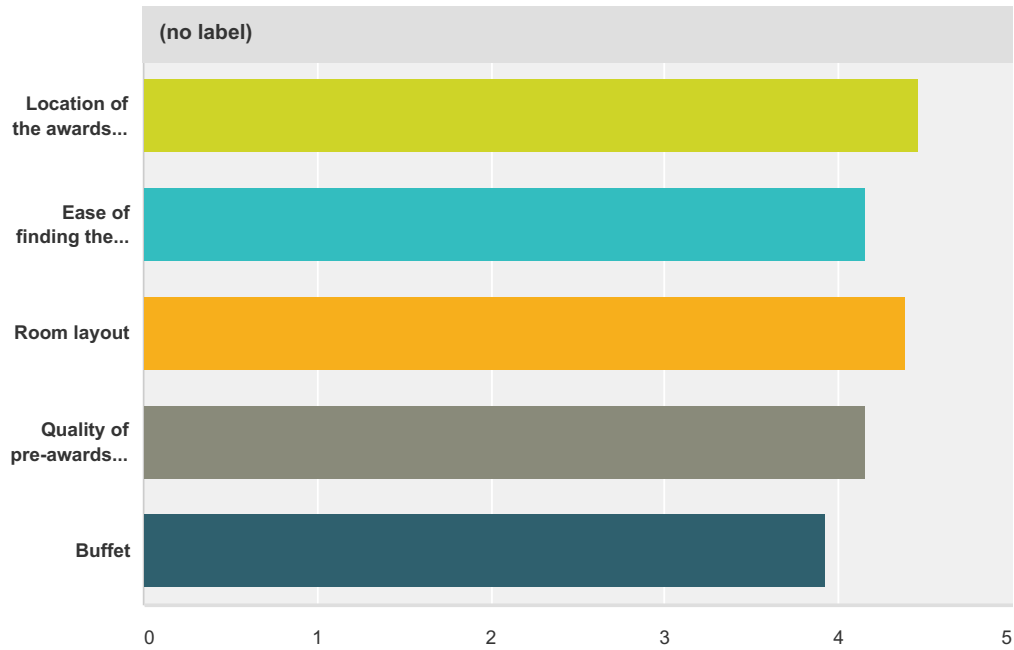

1. Overall the ceremony was good and guest I has with me felt it was pitched at a level that was still of interest to those who had little or no experience of work within NHS. One thing I feel may have been good to include, was to mention how many candidates undertook each examination (or what the percentage of candidates passing the examinations was) as I felt this would have demonstrated the level of achievement of those collecting awards. I (& my guest) felt very welcome and included in the day, and enjoyed it very much.
2. A small section on 'where to go now' might be beneficial. I note that IHRIM offer other qualifications (award, diploma etc) but don't know much about them. After sitting the NCCQ working out what to do next is a bit difficult ie do I wait 3 years and try to do my auditing/training exams, do I branch out and gain more knowledge of informatics as a whole? There's no set path so offering a little advice on career progression might have been good. This could have even been sent out with the exam results - 'well done, you passed - what next? Have you considered? etc.' A chance to sell yourselves!
